He collaborates with international resonance companies including: Armani, Ermenegildo Zegna, Inghirami, Armata di Mare, Channels, Flyng Cross and magazines such as: Mondo Uomo, Rockstar, Superbe etc.

Since 2005, De Martino leaves fashion photography and is dedicated to art.
